

# OLDE TYME DAYS ANTIQUÉ TRACTOR PULL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Hook fee will be \$10.00
2. All operators must be members of SOUTH CENTRAL PENN HISTORIC AND POWER SOCIETY.
3. Operators must be 16 years old to participate.
4. Four-wheel drive is not permitted to be used during the pull.
5. First puller in each weight class will be test puller and will be permitted to immediately pull again or drop to 6<sup>th</sup> position for his/her second attempt, no more dropping to last position. The distance from second attempt will be the distance recorded in that weight class.
6. All Tractors will be allowed 100 lbs over the divisions weight class limit. (Ex: 3000lbs. allowed 3100lbs)
7. A single tractor may only pull in one type of class-either stock, enhanced or open, not a combination.
8. All tractors may pull three times, but only once per weight class.

## 9. **Stock classes – 3 mph limit and 1<sup>st</sup> gear only.**

- a. Tractors must be 1959 and older to participate, unless the same model may have been built later (i.e. John Deere 30 series)
- b. Tractors must have original motor ( i.e. Super 88 Oliver must have Super 88 motor)
- c. All governors must be set to factory or less than 10% over specs.
- d. Fuel delivery and ignition system must be stock.
- e. Tractors pulling 6500 lbs. or less must use 15.5 x 38 or smaller tires.
- f. Tire size is not limited for tractors pulling 7500 lbs or more.
- g. No cut or altered tires.
- h. Stock classes are as follows:

i. 2500	iv. 5500	vii. 8500
ii. 3500	v. 6500	viii. 9500
iii. 4500	vi. 7500	ix. 10500

## 10. **Enhanced stock classes – 6 mph limit.**

- a. Tractors are not subject to an age limit.
- b. Tractors must have original motor ( i.e. Super 88 Oliver must have Super 88 motor)
- c. Full cut tire 18.4 maximum size.
- d. Enhanced stock classes are as follows:

i. 2500	v. 6500	ix. 10500
ii. 3500	vi. 7500	x. 11000
iii. 4500	vii. 8500	xi. 13000
iv. 5500	viii. 9500	

## 11. **Open Classes -**

- a. Tractors are not subject to an age limit.
- b. Open classes are as follows:

i. 2500	iv. 5500	vii. 8500
ii. 3500	v. 6500	viii. 9500
iii. 4500	vi. 7500	ix. 10500

12. There will also be an **unlimited class** for all tractors weighing more than 13,000 lbs.
13. Clevis and drawbar should be of good structure.
14. Drawbar height needs to be 20" **max.** and drawbar length needs to be 18" **min.** behind center line of rear axle.
15. Tractor must be in neutral when being hooked to the sled.
16. Operator must keep hands visible to the sled operator while being hooked.
17. Operator must stay seated at all times during pull.
18. No pulling or pushing of governor during pull is permitted.
19. Tractors in classes with speed limits will be disqualified after two horn blows.
20. Tractor wheel stand will be at flagman's discretion.
21. Driver must stop for red flag.
22. All weights must be securely fastened.
23. Anything falling off a tractor will result in disqualification.
24. The top three pullers in each class may be rescaled.
25. All Operators must attend meeting 20 minutes before pull.
